Dear friends,

Hope you and your family are keeping safe and healthy during the unprecedented times of COVID-19!

I have been supporting a local nonprofit, Children’s Eyes on the Globe (CEG, <http://www.childreneyesontheglobe.org/>) over years, and would like to share with you the efforts and contributions of the local Chinese community in response to the pandemic over the past few weeks.

During the current COVID-19 outbreak, we have brought over 200 packages of household hygiene and cleaning products to fellow Hoosiers in need served by the Mary Rigg Neighborhood Center since mid-March. In partnership with several other local organizations, we have also brought over 26,000 masks and other personal protective equipment to healthcare professionals and first responders at 29 hospitals and clinics, 4 senior living communities, 2 local police departments, 1 fire department and 1 post office.

More recently, we started a meal delivery project last Friday and have brought more than 300 hot meals so far to frontline care teams working at St. Vincent Hospital Indianapolis. Per requests, we will increase the number of meals to 400 this week and starting from next week, we will deliver **600 meals every week** to frontline care teams at two hospitals treating COVID-19 patients in Marion County—**St. Vincent Hospital Indianapolis** and **IU Health Methodist Hospital**.

One simple meal

= more time to focus on patients;

= more strength to persevere and endure in order to save lives;

= a huge thank from all of us to our healthcare heroes; and

= a word of encouragement telling them that they are not alone in this fight.

Yesterday, our crowdfunding campaign on GoFundMe was approved to be **eligible for matching funds up to \$1,000!** In order to receive the matching, we

will need to raise at least \$1,000 from 10 or more different donors through our GoFundMe campaign between April 16 and May 10. With all of the support, we are hoping to bring hot meals to more healthcare staff at local hospitals in Marion County—the county with most deaths and most confirmed cases in Indiana.

I would like to ask you to help spread the word about this meal delivery project, so that more people in local communities are aware of this project and will join us in supporting frontline care teams in Indianapolis.
